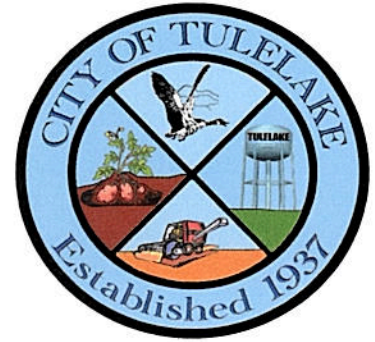

All dog owners need to purchase a dog license from City Hall. If your dog is 8 months or older and you reside within the City of Tulelake, you need to have your dog vaccinated against rabies and licensed.

Dog License Fees are as follows: \$12 for unaltered pets, \$7 for spayed or neutered pets and if you are over the age of 60 your fee is \$5 for each license. Please bring proof of rabies vaccination with you when you come in.

For the safety of your dog and the public, please keep your dog on a leash!



ELECTIONS:

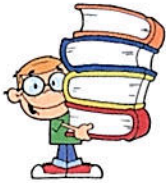
The candidate filing period for anyone interested in running for the Tulelake City Council is July 18, 2016 through August 12, 2016. Two City Council positions have reached

Sewer Rate Increase:

A public meeting was held at City Hall on December 1, 2015, regarding proposed changes to the sewer rates. The rate increase will help cover the costs of the new Wastewater Treatment Plant. Starting July 1, 2016, you will see an increase of \$6.60 on your utility bill. The sewer rate is changing from \$38.40 to \$45.00. Please be patient with us as we work to get the billing changes correct for your accounts. Thank you!

Burn Pit:

SUMMER HOURS:

The burn pit is officially open! The construction of the new wastewater treatment plant may, at times, interfere with dumping at the burn pit. If your access is impeded by heavy equipment you may dump your yard clippings next to the cell tower by the Fire Department. Please be watchful of the heavy equipment!!

You will notice a \$5.00 increase on your City utility bill for burn pit services. We encourage you to use the burn pit for all your gardening needs. Remember the Burn Pit is for yard clippings only! Do not throw household garbage in the burn pit.

You must live within the City limits to use the burn pit. Thank you!
