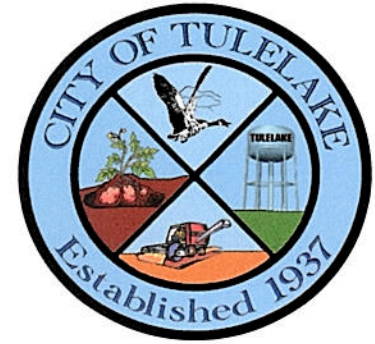

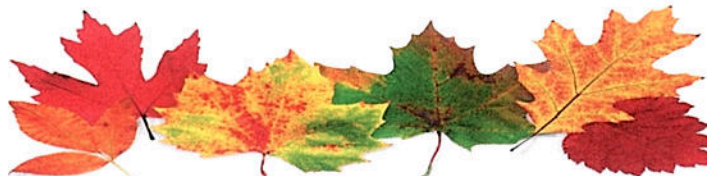

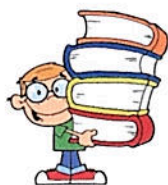

Burn Pit:

Remember the Burn Pit is for yard clippings only! **Do not throw household garbage** in the burn pit. You must live within the City limits to use the burn pit. Thank you!

Water Rate Increase:

Starting August 20, 2016 the base rate for water will increase from \$24.54 to \$28.05 for City residents, commercial and outside water districts. Overage charges on water will remain the same. Call City Hall if you have any questions.

Sewer Rate Increase:

Starting July 1, 2016, an increase appeared on your utility bill. The sewer rate changed from \$38.40 to \$45.00. This increase was mandated by the State in order to fund the new required sewer plant.
