

The City of Tulelake is applying for funding under a US Environmental Protection (EPA) Agency Brownfields Cleanup Grant to address impacts at one Brownfield property in Tulelake. As a result, the City of Tulelake solicits public comments on the draft USEPA Brownfield Cleanup Grant Application and the draft Analysis of Brownfield Cleanup Alternatives (ABCA) report for the one Brownfield site.

Public Notice

The City of Tulelake invites members of the public and the community to provide comments on the draft USEPA Brownfield Cleanup Grant Application and a Draft Analysis of Brownfield Cleanup Alternatives (ABCA) reports for property located at 800 G Street in Tulelake, California. The Draft ABCA report was prepared in advance of a USEPA Brownfield Cleanup Grant application. The Draft ABCA report outlines cleanup alternatives to address environmental impacts that will support future redevelopment of the Brownfield property.

Property Information

800 G Street

The site was previously occupied by Tri-County Agriculture until November 2023. The northern portion of the site was previously utilized as a storage and distribution center for fertilizer and other agricultural products. The southern portion of the site was previously utilized as an agricultural field. Due to these previous operations, constituents (including petroleum hydrocarbons, lead and per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances [PFAS]) are present in the subsurface beneath the site.
