NEW HOME OWNERS

The City of Tulelake provides water, sewer and garbage service to all residents. If you are a new home owner you **MUST** apply for these services before water will be turned on or garbage will be collected. Even if you are not living there, you are still liable for the sewer fees because your home is connected to the city sewer lines. Fees will be assessed from the date escrow closed on the home or if you are doing an owner carry purchase, the day you took possession of the home. Please stop

LOCAL RABIES CONTROL AND DOG LICENSES

The California Department of Public Health declared all 58 counties in California as "rabies areas" for 2017 due to the continued detection of rabies virus in wildlife and the threat posed to domestic pets, livestock and humans.

The city has an Ordinance in place (No. 6.04.020) that requires all residents, with an animal over eight months old, to obtain a license. California rabies control laws are requiring that the owner of every dog four months of age and older must ensure that his/her dog is vaccinated for rabies and licensed. Starting July 1, 2018 **ALL** residents within the city limits **MUST** have a license for their pet, which requires proof of vaccination for rabies.



Recycling Bins

The City of Tulelake has recycling bins located at the end of C St. near Otis Roper Park. Acceptable items are glass and plastic containers with lids removed, tin and aluminum cans. Please sort items into appropriate bins **AND DO NOT** bring any paper products, household garbage, yard garage, oil containers, cardboard, lids or styrofoam



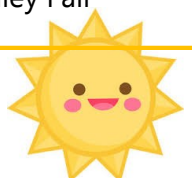
