APPROVAL OF THE MARCH 21, 2017 REGULAR MEETING MINUTES

PUBLIC HEARING TO OBTAIN INPUT FOR POSSIBLE STATE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROJECTS PROVIDING ASSISTANCE TO LOW INCOME RESIDENTS WITH HOUSING, ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND INFRASTRUCTURES

UPDATE ON CITY AGREEING TO GIVE THE TULELAKE UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT A 60 FOOT BY 230 FOOT PIECE OF LAND LOCATED ON THE WEST SIDE OF THE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL (PARCEL # 050-091-080-000)
